Originally made in a heavy Polycotton Canvas with stripes, Nowadays the blinds are also available in Plain Canvas colours and also in Shade Mesh with either a 94% or 99% UV blockout and with a wide variety of colours available. Shade mesh offer the best shade while still allowing a view of the outside and maintaining privacy from looking in

The blinds are easily operated using a rope & pulley system either through the timber window frame or down the outside wall to the ground level. and can be left at various positions on the side guide rails. Different size angle brackets are available to allow for more air circulation between the fabric and the glass if required and also to allow awning style windows to open still while the blind is down.

The Guide rails and brackets are Zinc coated as standard with Stainless Steel parts available as an option, Stainless steel is ideal when installed in close proximity to coastal beach areas

The Hood pelmet covers are available in a wide selection of Colorbond colours to match most traditional and modern colour schemes. The hoods can also be custom powder coated if required.

Operation

The simplicity of the rope and pulley operation has been one of the main reason the Fixed Guide awning has been popular for so many decades.

By simply pulling the rope and pulley to lower the blind to any position and tie off to leave the blind at the desired height.

When the blind is to be raised, simply release the rope from the cleat and the fabric will roll up to stow away under the protective pelmet hood.

The Fixed Guide awning blind can also be motorised and operated using a simple press of a button.
